FAILING FORWARD TO SUCCESS

THE PROBLEM:

- 99% of failures come from people who have the habit of making excuses. Quote by George Washington Carver.
- Many people would learn from their mistakes if they weren't so busy denying them. Quote by J. Harold Smith.
- Excuse-makers risk being seen as deceptive, self-absorbed, and ineffectual; they are viewed as unreliable social participants with flawed character.
- Lower the Frustration Level. Students' seeming "band attitudes" may be primarily due to their not being able to do the work (Bacon 1990). A high level of student frustration contributes significantly to negative behaviors.
